

Activity Pack Agreement

Activity packs are provided for children with special needs, developmentally disabled adults, and individuals with Alzheimer's or dementia. Teachers may also request a pack to use in their classroom if they service students with additional learning needs. If an adult client is unable to make the request themselves a parent, guardian, or teacher may make the request on their behalf and take responsibility for the activity pack.

We understand that normal wear happens. There is no charge for an activity pack, however, if items are lost or damaged beyond use we do ask that families or teachers replace the missing or severely damaged item. We suggest keeping all items in the bag provided when they are not in use so they don't get lost.

Rise Disability Resources does not select the activity pack items for an individual. The person checking the pack out is responsible for ensuring the items selected are safe for the recipient and providing any needed supervision.

Volunteers will deliver the packs to your home or classroom. The packs may be kept for up to 2 weeks. By the end of the 2 week period you agree to schedule a pickup of the pack by calling (805) 723-0455 or emailing us at help@risedisability.org. You may request new items when you schedule your pickup. During the first drop off you will need to show the volunteer picture identification or proof of address.

The first time an activity pack is requested by an individual/family there is a limit of 3 items and a board game. If the first activity pack is returned on time the individual/family may request 4 items and a board game for future activity packs. Board games can be a fun way to include siblings or other family members. Teachers may request 5 items and 2 board games for classroom use.

We encourage you to provide feedback on the items and let us know what items you would like to see available in the future.
